Through this endeavor, we hope to provide a space for all artists to come and collaborate to grow their skills as an artist ensuring equitable access to communication and build networks within our community. We are nearly done finalizing our organization's core values as our guiding star to help ensure we continue supporting Deaf Spotlight and arts in different ways- Be on the lookout for that.






